Old Business:

- VAN update (Mark and Julie): (1) Catch Healthy Habits (in conjunction with Oasis organization) is being coordinated by Merry Roth in the communities of Alexandria and Wilmar, and begins this fall; funding via Bremer Bank. (2) VAN will be hosting "InsideOut" workshops in Bloomington and Roseville in Aug and Sept. (See the VAN website for details.) (3) Aging with Gusto is ongoing. (4) Mapping Your Retirement is scheduled for this fall. (5) VAN is scheduling a date in Nov (6th??), probably 4-6pm, for an "joint appreciation" social gathering of the leaders of VAN and its task forces (including EvolvingConnections Task Force).
- Evolve classes update (Mark and Julie): (1) Recruiting is on-going for the Roseville Evolve class to begin this fall. **ACTION:** Julie is requesting our help in recuiting stu-

dents (see below) (2) Bloomington will be a new site for Evolve, with classes in April through Nov, 2015. (3) VAN's 50+ Wellness project is adding the Phillips neighborhood of Mpls and the community of Oakdale to the existing communities (Alexandria and Hamline-Midway) in the program. (4) Julie handed out a compilation of data regarding the demographics of the (ALVA and) Evolve classes from 2008 through spring 2014. (5) The current Wellness 50+ Evolve students will have a kick-off event with the new students on Nov 5.

- Book & Brew: Has an event this evening at Northern Clay Center.
- Consider including the Wellness 50+ Evolve students in EvolvingConnections communications and activities: Discussed. Julie noted that these students have access to all Evolve and EvolvingConnections info on the VAN and Evolve webpages. **ACTION:** Julie will consider the advisability of this from a potential "information over-load" perspective, given the specialized nature of that group's focus, and we will discuss at our next ECTF mtg.
- Future Happy Hours: See calendar. **ACTION:** As confirmed by Brad today, **Brad and Merry** will work with **Kathy Ramundt** in making suggestions to the EC Task Force as to a workable schedule / format for example, quarterly social gatherings alternating between the two sites.

New Business:

- Refine calendar of 2014 activities: See attached calendar.
- Vision / Mission / "our essence": In preparation for today's mtg, Judy sent out an email suggesting that we
- "prepare an action plan for 2015. Could we map the vision and mission to specific KINDS of events we want to do next year? The next steps after that could be creating an event plan for the year. Do we want one event per month? One every other month? Quarter? What kinds of events are task force members willing to work on? BTW what is the time commitment for being on the task force, one year?"

Discussion centered on developing a list of descriptors to use in assessing current and potential ECTF activities as to how well any given item fits our Vision or Mission. As a rough beginning, it was suggested that each item could be assessed as fitting any or all of the following (A through G):

- A Social or networking
- B Exploration of mutual interests
- C Educational opportunity
- D Maintenance of personal connections developed in Evolve classes
- E Maintenance of community leadership skills
- F Support of one another in completing past or future projects

G Enhance the vitality and sustainability of the Evolve program

ACTION: Wordsmiths can feel free to go to town on this, and all should be prepared to discuss further at our October ECTF meeting. Judy will do an initial refinement and send it out to us.

- Recruitment for future Evolve classes: Julie noted ongoing difficulties finding enrollees to commit to each new class, in spite of it's being very clear that those who complete an Evolve class are generally very pleased with the results. Julie and Brad mentioned examples of some gatherings in the metro and outstate areas (eg, the fall 2014 SALT [Senior Adults Learning Together], or The 2014 Women's Congress for Future Generations) that might provide productive venues using, for example, two Evolve grads / EC Task Force members to "staff a table" to provide information and to answer questions. Brad suggested having an Evolve banner for such activities. ACTION: ECTF members are asked to bring suggestions to our next mtg of known scheduled venues / seminars / gatherings that might prove fruitful in future recruiting efforts.
